- 1. In the space below, draw a staff (5 lines evenly spaced with a ruler) and a treble clef.
- 2. Draw bar lines to make eight even-sized measures.
- 3. Write a meter sign.
- 4. Start composing a melody by writing whole, half, quarter, and eighth notes and rests.
- 5. Make sure notes and rests add up to the correct number of beats in your meter sign.
- 6. With help from your instructor, input the melody into QComposer at Quavermusic.com.
- 7. If you don't like your melody, change it.
- 8. Give your melody a name and save it, one day everyone might be singing it... "Duude"!
