Write a chorus in reggae style to go with the "What's in the Coleslaw" backing track.

Each line of the chorus has 8 beats. Read through the sample lyrics, tapping your finger on each beatbox to keep a steady beat. Notice that some words are sep-a-rat-ed by dashes to carry across several boxes (or measures) while some words with multiple syllables are crunched together to be said quickly as one beat.

Place your own words into the beat boxes below to create a new chorus.
